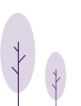

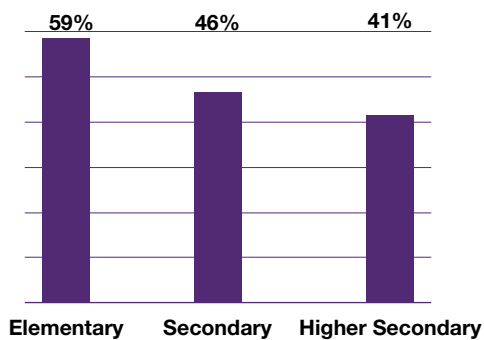

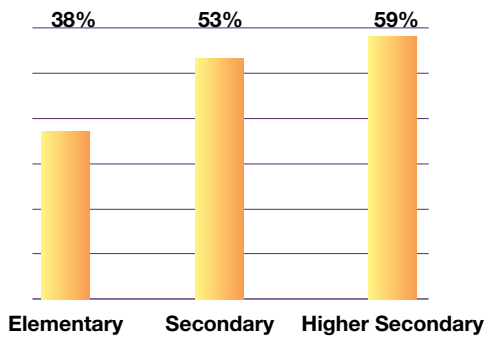

AFFILIATING BOARDS



Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)

Established in 1962 under the purview of MHRD, CBSE gives affiliations to both public and private schools. The board conducts the final examinations, All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) for classes X and XII.



Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE)

It is a private, non-governmental education board in India. It conducts the ICSE (for class X) and ISC (for class XII) examinations in India.



International Baccalaureate Organisation (IBO)

IBO was founded in 1968 as an international, non-governmental, non-profit educational organization based in Geneva, Switzerland. IB World Schools in India offer three IB programs—Primary Years Program (PYP), Middle Years Program (MYP) and IB Diploma Program (IBDP).



Cambridge International Examinations (CIE)

Cambridge International Examinations (formerly known as the University of Cambridge International Examinations) is a provider of international qualifications offering examinations and qualifications in more than 160 countries.



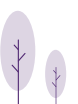
State Government Boards

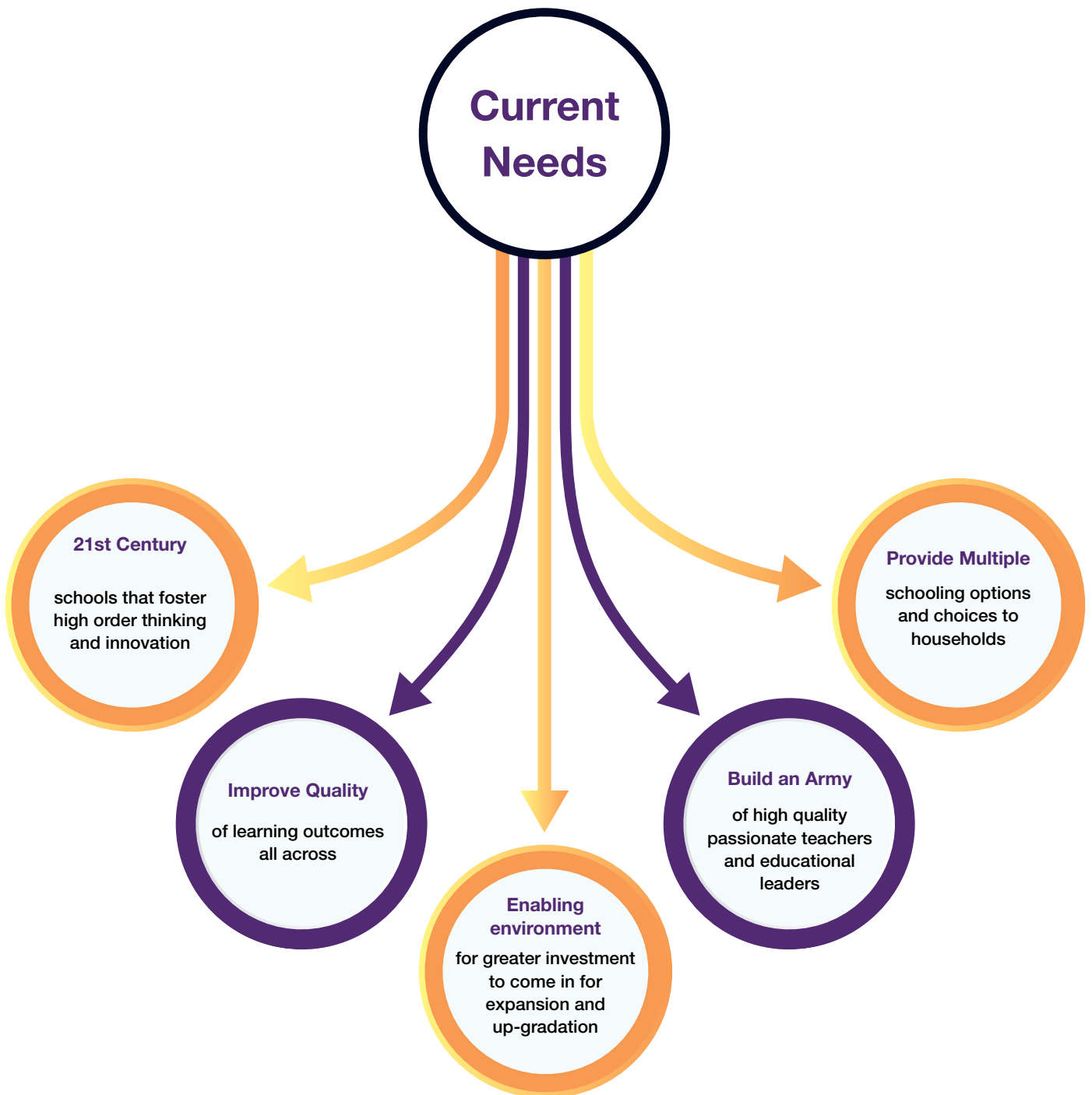
These educational boards are regulated and supervised by the state apex organisation for secondary and senior secondary education. Uttar Pradesh has the highest number of State board schools followed by Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, and Maharashtra.



National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS)

It is the board of education for distance education, under the Union Government of India. It provides several vocational, life enrichment, and community-oriented courses besides general and academic courses at the secondary and senior secondary levels.





GOVERNMENT AS AN ENABLER

POLICY LEVEL

NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY

The National Education Policy (NEP) is a comprehensive framework to guide the development of education in the country. As a policy of education, it not only guides the development of education but also provides directions for regulating and promoting education. This policy covers education at all stages, including early childhood care and education, school education, higher education, teacher education, and vocational education.

SAMAGRA SHIKSHA

With the objective to treat school education holistically without segmentation from pre-nursery to Class 12, an Integrated Scheme for School Education (Samagra Shiksha) has been created by subsuming the three Centrally Sponsored Schemes of SSA, Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (TE) extending Central support across all levels of school education for improving school effectiveness measured in terms of equal opportunities for schooling and equitable learning outcomes.

RIGHT TO EDUCATION

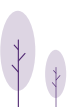
Education Act or Right to Education Act (RTE) is an Act of the Parliament of India enacted on 4 August 2009, which describes the modalities of the importance of free and compulsory education for children between the age of 6 to 14 years in India under Article 21A of the Indian Constitution. India became one of 135 countries to make education a fundamental right of every child when the act came into force on April 1, 2010. The title of the RTE Act incorporates the words 'free and compulsory.'

NATIONAL ASSESSMENT SURVEY

NAS 2017 has been conducted to map progress towards achieving the learning outcomes and to monitor the health of the country's education system. It used the district as the sampling frame and was based on an assessment framework developed to assess the learning levels based on subject-specific Learning Outcomes (LO) for Classes III, V, and VIII.

NATIONAL CURRICULUM FRAMEWORK

The National Curriculum Framework (NCF) for the Foundational Stage is developed based on the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, and to enable its implementation. The Foundational Stage refers to children in the age group of 3 to 8 years, across the entire range of diverse institutions in India. This is the first Stage in the 5+3+3+4 Curricular and Pedagogical restructuring of School Education as envisioned in NEP 2020.





NATIONAL PROGRAMME OF MID-DAY MEAL IN SCHOOLS

The scheme was extended to cover children in upper primary classes. It was renamed as ‘National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools’. The programme aims at (i) improving the nutritional status of children in Classes I-VIII, (ii) encouraging poor children, belonging to disadvantaged sections, to attend schools more regularly and help them concentrate on classroom activities, and (iii) providing nutritional support to children at the elementary stage of education in drought-affected areas during summer vacation.

PROMOTING DIGITAL ACCESS

NATIONAL DIGITAL INFRASTRUCTURE: NDEAR

The National Digital Education Architecture (NDEAR) is an architectural blueprint that aims to facilitate achieving the goals laid out in the National Education Policy, 2020, through a unified digital infrastructure in the education ecosystem. NDEAR enables a coherent multi-channel, multimodal, learning continuum at school, after school, at the community center, at home synchronous/ asynchronous, offline/ online, physical/ digital, self-service/ assisted.

NATIONAL DIGITAL PLATFORM FOR TEACHERS: DIKSHA

DIKSHA is a unique initiative which leverages existing highly scalable and flexible digital infrastructures, while keeping teachers at the centre. It provides quality e-content for school education in States/UTs and QR Coded Energized Textbooks for all grades (one nation, one digital platform).

LARGEST LMIS: UDISE

Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE) initiated in 2012-13, integrating DISE for elementary and secondary education is one of the largest Management Information Systems on school education covering more than 1.5 million schools, more than 9.6 million teachers and more than 264 million children.

TEACHER TRAINING: NISHTHA

NISHTHA is a capacity-building program for “Improving Quality of School Education through Integrated Teacher Training.” It aims to build competencies among all the teachers and school principals at the elementary stage. NISHTHA is the world’s largest teachers’ training programme of its kind. The basic objective of this massive training programme is to motivate and equip teachers to encourage and foster critical thinking in students. The initiative is first of its kind wherein standardized training modules are developed at national level for all States and UTs.

LARGEST DIGITAL REPOSITORY FOR ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS: NAD/DIGI-LOCKER

The National Academic Depository (NAD) is a 24X7 online repository of all academic awards such as certificates, diplomas, degrees, mark sheets, etc., issued by Academic Institutions such as universities, colleges, research institutes, training academies, and secondary education boards and stored in a digital format. Digi-Locker or NAD not only allows easy access and retrieval of academic awards but also validates and guarantees their authenticity and safe storage.



INNOVATION IN TEACHING & LEARNING



NATIONAL CREDIT FRAMEWORK

Government is finalizing a first of its kind 'National Credit Framework' (NCrF), which proposes to bring the entire education system from school onwards into the academic credit regime- with due weightage to curricular activities, sports, school/ university projects and internships.

PROMOTING INNOVATION & ENTREPRENEURSHIP



ATAL TINKERING LABS (ATL)

ATL is an approach of the Central Government of India to create an environment of scientific temperament, innovation, and creativity amongst Indian students. The objective of this scheme is to foster curiosity, creativity, and imagination in young minds and inculcate skills such as design mindset, computational thinking, adaptive learning, physical computing, etc.



SCHOOL INNOVATION AMBASSADORS

Government to promote innovation & entrepreneurship has trained 20,000 school innovation ambassadors. The next level of intervention is to ensure the integration of 21st-century skills. Activities are being organised around AI-based skills, hackathons, national-level Olympiads etc.



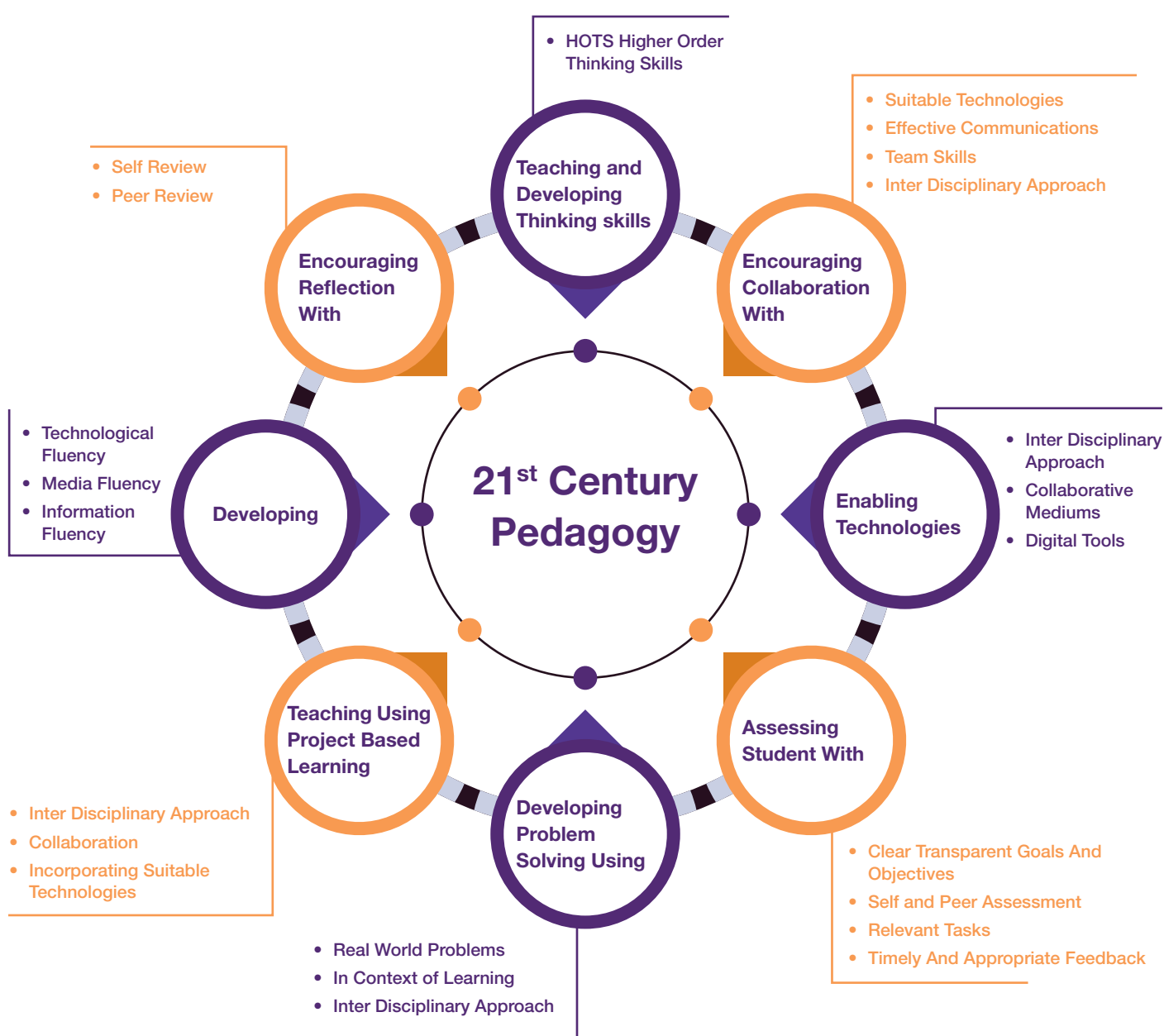
MENTAL HEALTH & WELL-BEING: MANODARPAN

An initiative by the Ministry of Education (MOE), Government of India (GOI) aims to provide psychosocial support for the mental health and well-being of students during the COVID outbreak and beyond. The platform includes a national toll-free helpline for students of schools, universities and colleges, which is manned by a pool of experienced counsellors, psychologists and mental health professionals. It also has a website, a national database of counsellors that hosts an interactive online chat platform, advisories and tips through webinars and other resources.



SELF-FINANCED SCHOOLS/ PRIVATE SCHOOLS AS FACILITATORS

Navigating the challenges and opportunities of the 21st century, self-financed/private schools have created a robust ecosystem which is guided by a comprehensive roadmap of curricular and assessment reforms, professional development of teachers and school leaders, integration of new-age technologies and fostering creativity, critical thinking and collaboration among learners. Following picture depicts the crucial contribution of self-financed/private schools in the creating a cohesive ecosystem in the country:





EMERGING TRENDS

With concerted Government efforts, India's internet user base crossed the 830 mn mark in 2021, growing by over 530 mn in the six years since 2015. The total volume of wireless internet data usage in India has surged over 7x to 32,397 petabytes in 2021 from around 4,200 petabytes in 2018. This revolutionary technology penetration has played an important role in the rise of technology in the education sector in India. (As per Economic Survey 2021-22, Govt. of India)

By 2030, India's education market is projected to increase to \$313 billion. The market size of the Ed-Tech industry is about \$2 billion. The opportunity is vast, given India has the largest population in the world in the age bracket of 5-24 years with 580 million people.

India is home to seven Ed-Tech Unicorns. In 2021-22, Ed-Tech was the third most-funded sector in India, raising over \$4.7 billion.

India's Ed-Tech is expected to reach US \$10.4 billion by 2025.

With the current enrolment of more than 250 mn students in the K-12 segment, it is the largest and most attractive segment for digital learning providers in India. In this segment of e-learning, further, sub-segments include smart class solutions, online tutoring, online preparation for exams, simulation, and virtual reality, STEM learning, AR and robotics, and assessment.

With growing trends in creators and the gig economy, there is a growing demand for upskilling and reskilling technologies. Tech-driven faculty development and engagement plans are also creating huge global collaboration opportunities.

Key Trends

Expansion to a new segment of learners

The growth of internet users and increased adoption of digital technologies is driving the rapid expansion of online education to Tier III and Tier IV cities, towns, and even remote areas.

Integration of VR, AR, and XR in day-to-day learning

The next couple of years will further see more innovations to enhance interactive learning by integrating new technologies like Virtual Reality (VR), Augmented Reality (AR), and Extended Reality (XR) that will enable students to observe and experience the concepts in a near-real environment.

Nano-learning

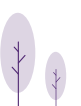
The attention span of modern learners is shrinking. Nano-learning will ensure that learners get ultra-bite-sized lessons and grasp their comprehension skills. WhatsApp, Slack, Teams, and many other platforms are being used to push 'nano-learning' content.

New-age assessments

Gamification of content has also ensured engaging ways of learners' assessments. Gamified elements of assessments such as progressing through levels, earning points, or getting badges are being used to create a more engaging and contemporary-looking evaluation of learning.

Integration of Future Learning Systems

Tech is also enabling to forge of global collaborations for learners, educators, and sectoral leaders. It is further expected to help in creating a cohesive ecosystem to prepare today's learners for the VUCA world. Tech-led Future Learning Systems will create frameworks for building competencies.

Sridevasena's success story of 'MORE CROP PER DROP' was presented at the third World Irrigation Forum held by the International Commission on Irrigation and Drainage (ICID), which was widely appreciated and recommended for implementation in other countries. She was also nominated to be part of the Indian delegation to the prestigious World Water Week held at Stockholm City in Sweden in August 2019, where she shared her experiences on sanitation in Peddapalli district.
